What do I need to pass this course?

You must achieve a passing grade of 80%.

What if I don't pass the test the first time?

You are allowed to repeat any or all sections of the course as many times as you need. You can take the final test up to three times to achieve the passing grade of 80%.

How long do I have to take the course?

After you purchase the course, you have one year to take it.

How long is my certification good for?

After I pay for the course, when can I get started?

I lost/forgot to print my certificate/wallet card?

Not a problem, you can reprint your certificate at any time, as long as it has not expired.
